The conference will be of interest to those working in the fields of adoption, fostering, childcare, youth work, mental health, CAMHS, play therapists, academics and psychologists.

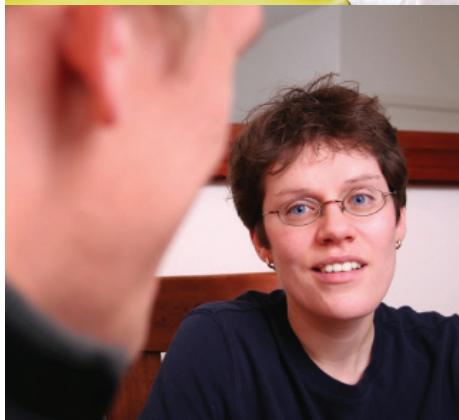
Keynote speakers: John Timpson, *Chairman of Timpson, adoptive parent and former foster carer*; Louise Bomber, *Attachment Support*
